



Welcome to the 5th annual *Global SOF Symposium - U.S.*! We first want to thank our international partners that have traveled to sunny Tampa to participate in this event. We are truly grateful to have you with us because the GSF would be nothing without your support.

This event started in St. Pete Beach in 2015, and we outgrew that venue and moved to Innisbrook Resort. At the end of 2017 the GSF Board of Directors elected to add more exhibits to the GSF events, thus leading us here to the Grand Hyatt Tampa Bay.

It is great being back on the water and closer to Tampa and St. Pete. For those of you that do not live in this area you will see massive change here over the next six years. Tampa has about \$6B in development going on downtown, and St. Pete is also experiencing significant growth. Being outside of downtown but also close enough to enjoy the area is critical.

We have grown over the last five years, but we have maintained the intimacy of the event. The number of government attendees has grown to approximately 24%, and we think that number will increase with our move here to the Grand Hyatt since it is closer to MacDill Air Force Base.





GRAND HYATT TAMPA BAY RESORT MAP







GRAND HYATT TAMPA BAY RESORT MAP



Mr. Emerson T. Brooking

Author, LikeWar: The Weaponization of Social Media

Emerson T. Brooking is the coauthor of *LikeWar: The Weaponization of Social Media* and an expert on the relationship between conflict and the internet. Most recently, he was Research Fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations—the

youngest scholar to receive such an appointment in recent institutional history. Previously, Mr. Brooking was Research Associate for Defense Policy, also at the Council on Foreign Relations, where he studied defense strategy, budgeting, and civil-military relations. He has served as an adviser on information warfare to the National Security Council, Joint Staff, and U.S. intelligence community.

Mr. Brooking's work has appeared in the Atlantic, Foreign Affairs, WIRED, and Rolling Stone, among others. He has provided commentary on defense and internet-related topics to NPR and was recently named to the Forbes "30 Under 30." Mr. Brooking holds a BA in Political Science and Classical Studies from the University of Pennsylvania.



Dr. Lisa A. Costa SES

Director, Communications Systems and Chief Information Officer, U.S. Special Operations Command

Dr. Lisa A. Costa, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Director, Communications Systems and Chief Information Officer, United States Special Operations

Command (USSOCOM), MacDill Air Force Base, Florida. She is responsible for developing USSOCOM's Information Technology (IT) strategy as well as executing the Command's C4 acquisition program. Dr. Costa is also responsible for operating and maintaining USSOCOM's global network providing support to more than 70,000 special operations personnel.

Dr. Costa previously served as the Senior Director of Innovation and Technology at Engility Corporation where she brought data and decision sciences together. She worked in artificial intelligence and machine learning across client verticals. Dr. Costa served as the Vice President of Intelligence and Chief Scientist at PlanetRisk, a global leader in 365/24/7 real-time predictive risk analytics. She brought progressive leadership tackling complex, sensitive intelligence problems facing nations and global industry. She was formerly the Director of Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD) and Violent Extremism at MITRE where she chaired MITRE's Corporate CWMD/CT Council and led work for senior sponsors. Before that, Dr. Costa was the Executive Director of Integration, the Enterprise Systems Engineer, for MITRE's National Security Center responsible for integrating across missions, sponsors, and programs. She provided executive strategic planning for business operations and advancing the Center's \$1.2B business hase

Dr. Costa was MITRE's Chief Scientist for the Combatant Commands and Defense and Service Intelligence agencies. She was on the OSD Senior Technical Experts Group and led MITRE IR&D to develop patented, globally licensed work in Enhancing Intelligence Analysis. Dr. Costa was responsible for establishing the largest data repository and data mining capability outside the NCR in support of special mission unit target adjudication. As Director of the Non-Traditional Information & Knowledge Exploitation cell, at USSOCOM, she led multidisciplinary teams to develop worldwide assessments. These efforts were at the request of Combatant Commanders via P4 to the Chairman, JCS. This work has been used as a model for intelligence centers across the globe and Dr. Costa is a plank holder in a number of big data cells.

Major General Maria R. Gervais received her Regular Army commission in 1987 as a Distinguished Military Graduate of the Lander College Reserve Officer Training Corps program

in Greenwood, South Carolina, and was assigned to the Chemical Branch.

Senate staff member for the Goldwater-Nichols Defense Reorganization Act and the Cohen-Nunn Amendment. In the first Bush and early Clinton administrations, Mr. Locher served as the assistant secretary of defense for special operations and low-intensity conflict. In 2003-2004, he chaired the Defense Reform Commission in Bosnia and Herzegovina that successfully merged the three warring factions. More recently, Mr. Locher served as president and CEO of the nonpartisan Project on National Security Reform.

In May 2018, Mr. James F. McDonnell was appointed by President Trump to serve as the Assistant Secretary for the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Countering Weapons

of Mass Destruction (CWMD) Office. The mission of the newly-established CWMD Office is to counter attempts by terrorists or other threat actors to carry out an attack against the United States or its interests using a weapon of mass destruction. Prior to this position, Mr. McDonnell was the acting Assistant Secretary of CWMD and the Director of the DHS Domestic Nuclear Detection Office.

Mr. McDonnell is a recognized expert in the area of WMD-related terrorism. He enlisted in the Navy in 1975 and retired as a commissioned officer after twenty years of service in special operations and counterterrorism. After leaving the Navy, he founded the National Security Programs business unit at Oak Ridge Associated Universities and managed a number of terrorism-related national security activities, including restructuring the technical response by the U.S. to nuclear terrorism threats.

Mr. McDonnell has senior executive experience in the federal government and the private sector, where he directed security, police, and other risk management functions. He has served in the Senior Executive Service in DHS, the Department of Energy, and the White House. Following the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, Mr. McDonnell became the founding director of the Department of Energy's Office of Energy Assurance, which is responsible for the protection of the nation's energy infrastructure.

Mr. McDonnell received his Bachelor of Science degree from Regents College, University of the State of New York, and earned a Master of Arts degree from Georgetown University. He also attended Harvard University's Senior Executives in National and International Security program. He has volunteered his time on boards, task forces, and advisory committees, with a focus on homeland security policy and community preparedness and response. Mr. McDonnell has published an article on nuclear terrorism response, as well as a book on domestic terrorism incidents. He has contributed to publications addressing corporate security, homeland security, and critical decision-making.






